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8 **For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the Grant and Other Money Projects**  
9 **Series for the “Public Art Contributions” program.**  
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12 **WHEREAS**, the City is in need of a capital fund to support the receipt of funds for public art  
13 projects from partner organizations and private entities; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the new fund will be for the planning, design, and construction of existing or new  
15 public art;  
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17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**  
18 **DENVER:**

20 **Section 1.** A new fund is hereby established in the Grant and Other Money Projects Fund,  
21 Accounting No. 38000, “Public Art Contributions”, Accounting No. 38650 for the purpose of  
22 accounting for capital expenditures related to public art projects.

23 **Section 2.** Monies received from partner organizations or private entitites shall be deposited  
24 into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described  
25 in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

26 **Section 3.** Expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Public Art Contributions” fund,  
27 Accounting No. 38650, in the amount not to exceed the total of deposits described in Section 2 of  
28 this Ordinance, to be expended by the Executive Director of Denver Arts and Venues. Authorized  
29 expenditures for Accounting No. 38650 include but are not limited to capital improvements, including  
30 planning, design or construction activities for public art installations. This is a sponsor-funded, non-  
31 lapsing fund.

32 **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized  
33 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be  
34 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
