A RESOLUTION

Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, concerning the “FY23 Denver Sheriff Department Medicated-Assistant Treatment Expansion” program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for the “FY23 Denver Sheriff Department Medicated-Assistant Treatment Expansion” program, which is identified as Grant Number 15PBJA-23-GG-00079-BRND, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 202369921, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 12000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of Safety, is as follows:
