### I. DEPARTMENTAL MATTERS IN THE REGULAR COURSE OF BUSINESS:

#### A. Mayor's Office - Anthony Aragon

RR15-0116 Approves the Mayoral appointments of Anna Jo Haynes and Penny May to the Denver Preschool Program Board of Directors for terms effective immediately and expiring 12-31-15 and approves the Mayoral appointments of Paul Asper, Judy Ham, Zach Hochstadt, Rebecca Kantor, Amber Munck, and Susan Steele for terms effective immediately and expiring 12-31-17, or until successors are duly appointed.

RR15-0119 Approves the Mayoral appointment of Chy Montoya to the Denver Latino Commission for a term effective immediately and expiring on 1-1-17, or until a successor is duly appointed.

#### B. Community Planning and Development - David Gaspers/ Savannah Jameson

BR15-0056 Rezones property at 195 South Monaco Parkway from E-SU-DX to S-MU-3 in Council District 5.

BR15-0117 Amends the Welton Street Cultural Historic District Ordinance 113 Series of 2002 by changing the name to the Five Points Historic Cultural District to more accurately reflect the district and its significance; changing the period of significance to include 1964; and to add two contributing structures: 2801-2807 Welton Street (Rice's Tap Room and Oven-Simpson Hotel-KC Lounge) and 2559-2563 Welton Street (Metropolitan Investment Company – Equity Savings and Loan Cousins Building) in Council District 8.

#### C. Denver International Airport - Aaron Barraza/ Amy Raaz

BR15-0113 Approves a contract with CGI Technologies and Solutions, Inc. in the amount of \$948,420 through 1-31-18 for ongoing maintenance and support of the CGI software used by Denver International Airport (201419206).

BR15-0114 Approves an agreement with Signature Technologies, Inc. (doing business as Com-net) in the amount of \$670,000 through 6-30-18 for the flight and baggage information display system upgrade, including system maintenance, application modules to include software support, and related software update releases for the existing customized software modules at Denver International Airport (201418873).

BR15-0123 Amends a contract with CenturyLink by extending the contract term for an additional two years through 6-1-16 for continuing professional on-call support to Denver International Airport network engineers, technicians, and project managers for maintenance services of the airport's Synchronous Optical Networking (SONET) infrastructure. No additional funds are being added to the contract (CE15006-3).

BR15-0124 Approves a contract with Flatiron Constructors, Inc. in the amount of \$35,271,112.50 for Runway 17L-35R Complex pavement and lighting rehabilitation at Denver International Airport in Council District 11 (201417577). The source of funds is from the Federal Airport Administration Airport Improvement Program (AIP)/Capital

Improvement Program (CIP).

D. Department of Safety - Ashley Kilroy/ Eric Tade/ Jeannie Springer/ Laura Wachter

- BR15-0109 Amends the Denver Revised Municipal Code making it unlawful to cultivate more than thirty-six (36) marijuana plants on any non-residential zone lot in the city, except in a licensed marijuana cultivation facility.
- BR15-0115 Authorizes expenditures in the amount of \$596,935 in the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund based on the grant award from the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) to award funding for the “High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (H.I.D.T.A.) FY15” program (G15RM0018A).
- BR15-0118 Amends an agreement with Colorado Coalition for the Homeless (CCH) by adding an additional year of services (a new end date of 12-31-15) at a cost of \$144,000 (for a new total cumulative cost of \$1,296,000) to provide Assertive Community Treatment “ACT” to mentally ill-homeless persons in the Court to Community court intervention program C(E-70053 (8)).

E. Human Services - Ron Mitchell

- BR15-0107 Appropriates 25% of the total Continuum of Care (formerly Shelter Plus Care) U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development grant award, or \$998,726.25, to provide direct rental assistance and case management to chronically homeless individuals and homeless individuals within the City.
- BR15-0106 Amends an agreement with Third Way Center, Inc. to add Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) language and updated rates for providing placements and case management services to children/youth in out-of-home care. There is no change to the total contract amount (2012-05750-02).
- BR15-0122 Approves a contract with the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless for \$593,097 through 6-30-15 to provide 240 units of tenant based rental assistance to chronically homeless individuals with substance abuse issues through the Continuum of Care Housing First program (SOCSV-TBD).

F. Office of Economic Development - Seneca Holmes

- BR15-0131 Authorizes Denver’s Division of Workforce (DWD) to grant a sub-award to the Larimer County Workforce Center in the amount of \$709,755.20 through 9-30-18 to provide services under grant agreement HG-26659-15-60-A-8 entitled H1-B Ready-to-Work from the Department of Labor (201520606).
- BR15-0130 Authorizes Denver’s Division of Workforce (DWD) to grant a sub-award to Boulder County Workforce Center in the amount of \$768,220.80 through 9-30-18 to provide services under grant agreement HG-26659-15-60-A-8 entitled H1-B Ready-to-Work from the Department of Labor (201520605).
- BR15-0129 Authorizes Denver’s Division of Workforce (DWD) to grant a sub-award to Arapahoe/Douglas Works in the amount of \$649,372 through 9-30-18 to provide services under grant agreement HG-26659-15-60-A-8 entitled H1-B Ready-to-Work from the Department of Labor (201520646).
- BR15-0128 Authorizes Denver’s Division of Workforce (DWD) to grant a sub-award to the Jefferson County America Job Center in the amount of \$735,581 through 9-30-18 to

provide services under the grant agreement of HG-26659-15-60-A-8 entitled H1-B Ready-to-Work from the Department of Labor (201520647).

G. Technology Services - Frank Daidone

BR15-0083 Grants Qwest Broadband Services, Inc., doing business as CenturyLink a nonexclusive franchise agreement with a duration of 10 years and authorization to make reasonable and lawful use of the Rights-of-Way within the City to construct, operate, maintain, reconstruct and rebuild a cable system for the purpose of providing cable television service in exchange for 5% of gross revenues.
