5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed:

In 2017, voters approved funding through Elevate Bond for design and construction of Denver Fire Station 40, originally to be located at 72nd Avenue and Tower Road. Through the land procurement process, the City of Denver obtained land for this station on DEN property, located at the northwest corner of 56th Avenue and Telluride Street.

The rapidly growing area of northeast Denver is lacking fire and emergency coverage per National Fire Protection Association standards. A fire station is needed specifically near the Tower Road corridor and Peña Boulevard. This project will build a new fire station at 56th Avenue and Telluride Street to respond to emergency incidents more quickly and meet the needs of this fast-growing community. The new station will enhance the neighborhood with a welcoming community facility and provide timely emergency services in a safe and professional manner.

This contract is for the construction phase of the Construction Manager/General Contractor (CM/GC) project to build the new Denver Fire Station 40 and supporting infrastructure.
