**A BILL**

**For an ordinance amending the annual salaries of certain appointed charter officers and the chief of police**

WHEREAS, Colorado Constitution Art. XX, Sec. 2 requires that the compensation of the officers of the City and County of Denver be expressed as a stated salary fixed by ordinance within limits fixed by the Charter; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with § 9.2.3 of the Charter the Career Service Board has determined a pay range for each appointed charter officer listed in § 9.2.1 (B) of the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the annual salaries set forth herein do not exceed the maximum salaries set forth in the pay ranges determined by the Career Service Board, as required by § 9.2.3 of the Charter; and

WHEREAS, § 9.6.4 of the Charter provides that the salary of the Chief of Police shall be as set forth in ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** That Chapter 18, Article III, Division 2, Section 18-91 of the Revised Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the language underlined and deleting the language stricken to read as follows:

**Section 18-91. Salaries.**

 2 charter officers in accordance with the limitations of section 9.2.3 of the Charter, the  
 3 council hereby fixes the annual salaries as follows:

 27 commanders shall receive the following annual salaries:
