The one-year extension allows the City to continue remediation and associated groundwater monitoring activities at existing City owned leaking underground storage tank (UST) sites. Work at the leaking UST sites is regulated and required by the State’s Division of Oil and Public Safety. Additionally, the contracted company will provide investigation, remediation, and other environmental services to City departments as requested, such as may be associated with the sale of a property or preparing a plan to meet environmental requirements.
