A BILL

For an ordinance making a rescission from and an appropriation in Denver Human Services, authorizing a cash transfer to the Community Development Special Revenue Fund, and making an appropriation in the Community Development Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, Denver Human Services (DHS) currently administers two transitional housing contracts which both DHS and the Department of Housing Stability (HOST) agree are more aligned with the scope of work performed by HOST; and

WHEREAS, these include a \$294,372 contract with the Salvation Army and a \$207,748 contract with Family Homestead; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance authorizes the cash transfer from DHS to a HOST Special Revenue Fund and establishes the budget authority under HOST to administer the contracts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From appropriations heretofore made from the Human Services Special Revenue Fund listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded" and transferred to the Human Services Special Revenue Fund:

10 designated the amount of money following such designation, to be expended for the purposes and
11 upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
