From Council Rules of Procedure (Rule 8)

- 8.1 Election of Officers. At the third meeting of the Council in the month of July of each year, except when a Council seat is vacant, the order of business shall be:
- (a) Election of a President as provided in section 3.3.1 of the Charter, who shall hold office until the third Monday of July of the ensuing year, or until a successor is duly elected, whichever is later.
- (b) Election of a president pro tempore who shall serve without additional compensation and who shall hold office until the third Monday of July of the ensuing year, or until a successor is duly elected, whichever is later.
- (c) The election of Council officers shall be conducted as follows:
- 1. Candidates for the office of President of Council, and of President Pro Tempore, shall be nominated from the floor, separately, before the election for each office.
- 2. No second to a nomination shall be required.
- 3. The nominations shall be closed by a declaration by the presiding officer after the presiding officer asks for further nominations and receives no reply.
- 4. The election for each office shall be in the form of a roll call election in which each member of Council, when called upon, declares his or her vote for a candidate.
- 5. An eligible person receiving a vote for an office need not have been nominated.
- 6. No nominee shall be removed from consideration unless he or she withdraws.
- 7. The candidate receiving at least seven votes for each office will be declared elected to that office by the presiding officer, after the verification by the Council Secretary of the votes cast.
- (d) If a Council seat is vacant at the time of the regularly scheduled election, the election for President and President Pro Tempore shall take place at the first regular Council meeting after every seat on the Council is filled.

CB10-0582 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Lease Agreement between the City and County of Denver and GE Johnson Construction Company. (FINANCE)

Approves a lease of 12,502 square foot City-owned land at 13th Avenue and Elati Street to GE Johnson Construction Company to use as a construction staging area in the amount of \$7,500 per month for a contract term commencing October 1, 2010 for 24 months. The tenant will pay \$25,000 to the City to defray the cost of restoring the property for future use. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-9-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-8-10.

Public Amenities

CB10-0583 A bill for an ordinance approving an Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Bridgeman Art Library International to allow the sale of certain copies of art work owned by the Denver Public Library. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)

Approves a 5-year contract allowing Bridgeman Art Library International to market and sell transparencies pieces from the Denver Public Library's art collection, with shared costs and revenues. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-9-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-8-10.

CB10-0542 A bill for an Ordinance approving a Development Agreement with LNR CPI High Point, LLC. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)

Approves an agreement providing for the timely and appropriate construction of infrastructure, including parks and recreation facilities, streets, drainage facilities, sanitary sewer facilities and water lines, by defining the responsibilities of all parties involved in development of High Point, northeast of Tower and 64th Ave. in Council District 11. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-9-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-8-10.

Safety

CB10-0589 A bill for an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed contract between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado concerning the "Community Corrections FY10-11" program and the funding therefor. (SAFETY)

Accepts \$13,145,961.36 from the State of Colorado for (Division of Criminal Justice and Department of Corrections) for the FY10-11 Community Corrections Programs. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-9-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-8-10.

CB10-0576 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and RRK Enterprises d/b/a Independence House for residential and non-residential community corrections services. (SAFETY)

Approves a \$2,717,453 contract with RRK Enterprises Inc. for community corrections services. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-9-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-8-10.

CB10-0575 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Correctional Management, Inc. for residential and non-residential community corrections services. (SAFETY)

Approve a \$3,202,048 contract with Correctional Management, Inc. for community corrections services. The last regularly-scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-9-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-8-10.

CB10-0572 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Airport Use and Facilities Lease Agreement between the City and County of Denver and American Eagle Airlines, Inc., related to leased space at Denver International Airport. (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT)

Adds five years to the current Airport Use and Facilities lease Agreement between the City and American Eagle Airlines (an express partner for American Airlines) for yearly revenue of \$214,000. The last regularly scheduled meeting within the 30-day period is on 8-2-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-24-10.

CB10-0566 A bill for an ordinance making rescissions of budget balances to close out grants, and transferring grant cash balances to the General Fund. (FINANCE)

Approves closing out several old grant budgets (totaling \$269,674.96) from completed projects and zeroing out the fund balances; and closing out cash fund balances (\$0). The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-1-10.

CB10-0534 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Mi Casa Resource Center, to provide TANF employment and training services. (NEIGHBORHOOD COMMUNITY & BUSINESS REVITALIZATION)

Approves a contract with Mi Casa Resource Center in the amount of \$521,140.00 in TANF funds for employment and training services. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-2-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-24-10.

CB10-0539 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Denver Options, Inc., to provide TANF employment and training services. (NEIGHBORHOOD COMMUNITY & BUSINESS REVITALIZATION)

Approves a contract with Denver Options, Inc. to provide funding from TANF grant funds to support employment and training services for a minimum of 629 Denver County residents. The contract term is July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011 and the contract cost is \$687,000. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-2-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-24-10.

CB10-0398 A bill for an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado concerning "Workforce Investment Act and Wagner-Peyser PY10/FY11" programs and the funding therefor. (NEIGHBORHOOD COMMUNITY & BUSINESS REVITALIZATION)

Authorizes an agreement between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado pertaining to the allocation of PY10/11 Workforce Investment Act, Wagner Peyser and Employer Support funds: PY10 WIA Adult = \$1,545,928; PY10 WIA Youth = \$1,568,883; PY10 WIA Dislocated Workers = \$1,256,077; PY10 Wagner Peyser = \$1,714,887; PY10 Employment Support Funds = \$450,000. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-2-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 5-10-10.

CB10-0352 A bill for an ordinance approving the third amendatory on-call agreement between American Civil Constructors and the City & County of Denver for Washington Park irrigation renovation. (PUBLIC AMENITIES) Amends the on-call contract with American Civil Constructors for landscape and irrigation construction services to add \$62,000 to complete two projects. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-2-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 5-7-10.

CB10-0363 A bill for an ordinance approving a non-financial agreement between the Colorado Miners, Inc., and the City & County of Denver to occupy and administer community programs at the Johnson Recreation Center. (PUBLIC AMENITIES)

Approves a partnership agreement between Denver Parks and Recreation and the non-profit Colorado Miners to administer sports and mentoring programs for Elyria Swansea neighborhood youth at the transitional Johnson Recreation Center. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-2-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 5-3-10.

CB10-0546 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed donation by the Girl Scouts of America, Mile High Council, of a mobile home to the City and County of Denver, in accordance with City Charter section 2.4.4(E). (PUBLIC AMENITIES)

Accepts donation of a mobile home the Girl Scouts installed and used for its summer camp program in Katherine Craig Park, near Genesse, from 1995 through 2009. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-1-10

CB10-0481 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory on-call agreement between Turner Construction Company and the City & County of Denver that will provide general construction services. (PUBLIC WORKS) Increases maximum work order for this on-call contract from \$400,000 to \$480,000 for Turner Construction to complete DPAC Galleria paving and snow melt work. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is 8-2-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-10-10.

CB10-0484 A bill for an ordinance approving a revived and amendatory oncall agreement between Architectural Energy Corporation and the City & County of Denver that will provide general construction services. (PUBLIC WORKS)

Extends the on-call contract with Architectural Energy for two years to April, 7, 2012, and increases its capacity from \$480,000 to \$960,000. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-2-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-10-10.

CB10-0496 A bill for an Ordinance designating certain properties in the vicinity of South Broadway between Wesley Avenue and Iowa Avenue as being required for public use and authorizing use and acquisition thereof by negotiation or through condemnation proceedings including all improvements, fixtures, licenses, permits, access points and any other rights and interests related or appurtenant to properties so designated. (PUBLIC WORKS)

Allows the City to acquire 41 temporary construction easements from private property owners through negotiation, purchase or condemnation to repair driveways and sidewalks as part of improvements on S. Broadway between Wesley and Iowa. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-2-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-17-10.

CB10-0538 A bill for an ordinance approving an intergovernmental agreement between the State of Colorado, Department of Transportation, and The City and County of Denver for the Federal Boulevard, Alameda Avenue to 5th Avenue, Improvement Project. (PUBLIC WORKS)

Allows the City to reimburse CDOT the required \$1,198,814 local match for the Federal Blvd. improvements between Alameda to 5th Ave. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-2-10. Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-24-10.

CB10-0543 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory intergovernmental agreement between the State of Colorado, Department of Transportation, Region 6 and the City & County of Denver for the North Denver Metro ITS Improvement Program. (PUBLIC WORKS)

Approves receipt and expenditure of an additional \$200,000 in federal funds, for a new total of \$729,000, for the implementation of two Dynamic Message Signs as part of the North Denver Metro ITS Improvement project, including field devices and communication infrastructure to improve data collection and dissemination of traveler information to assist in managing recurring traffic problems. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-2-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-1-10.

CB10-0544 A bill for an ordinance approving an on-call agreement between Roadsafe Traffic Systems, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for the 2010 Pavement Marking Project. (PUBLIC WORKS)

Approves a \$794,250 one-year on-call contract with Roadsafe for installation of various pavement markings Citywide. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-2-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-1-10.

CB10-0559 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed contract between the City and County of Denver and Keene Concrete, Inc. for the 2010 Citywide Curb, Gutter and Crosspan Project, Phase III. (PUBLIC WORKS) Approves a \$1,224,248.50 contract with Keene Concrete for Citywide curb, gutter cross-pan and concrete repairs. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 8-2-10. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 7-1-10.
