9 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

10 **Section 1.** That subsection 14-2 (b), D.R.M.C. shall be amended by deleting the language
11 stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

13 **Sec. 14-2. Number and salary of judges.**

14 (b) Each county judge shall be paid a salary equal to a compa-ratio of ~~1.076~~ 1.039 of the
15 pay grade ~~821-L~~ applicable to the job classification entitled "Assistant City Attorney—
16 Section Supervisor" in the legal occupational group ~~in~~ of the classification and pay plan
17 adopted and maintained in accordance with chapter 18, division 2 of article II; provided,
18 however, in no event shall any judge's salary be reduced during the judge's term of office.

20 **Section 2.** This ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2014.
