A RESOLUTION

Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) concerning the “Pathways to Removing Obstacles to Housing (PRO Housing) Grant” program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the “Pathways to Removing Obstacles to Housing (PRO Housing) Grant” program, which is identified as Grant Number B-23-PH-08-0002, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 202475382, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of Community Planning and Development, is as follows:
