All work is in collaboration with the Principal Investigator (Dr. Kathryn Wells), the Director of Training and Replication, and DHS Project Director. Under this scope of work, Kempe is responsible for the primary management of day-to-day grant operation and activities, project evaluation, and collaboration to ensure all grant requirements are completed.
