A RESOLUTION

Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed amended Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Human Services, Behavioral Health Administration concerning the “Persistent Drunk Drivers FY25 Grant” program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed amended Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Colorado Department of Human Services, Behavioral Health Administration, for the “Persistent Drunk Drivers FY25 Grant” program, which is identified as Grant Number 25 IBEH 189102, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 202474105, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the Colorado Department of Human Services, Behavioral Health Administration to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 12000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Presiding Judge is as follows:

Expenditure of said funds are authorized for the period from August 28, 2020 to June 30, 2025. This grant contract is amended by adding \$115,000 for State Fiscal Year 2025 for a total contract amount of \$558,806.
