  - a. Scope of Work

This ordinance will approve a two-year term agreement (1/1/11 to 12/31/12) for Theatres & Arenas Promoter Commission Program to induce Promoters to host events in City venues. The venues in question are in Council District 8 (DPAC venues) and Council District 9 (Denver Coliseum) and Red Rocks. The promoters will promote and book live concerts and events at the Theatres and Arenas Venues. This commission program is a rental incentive to increase revenues in the form of ticket sales and concessions.
