General description or background of proposed request:  Denver International Airport (DEN) is seeking Council approval for a contract with Peak Consulting Group, LLC for Peña Boulevard Design Services and NEPA (I-70 to E-470) at Denver International Airport (DEN) for a duration of five years from the Notice to Proceed (NTP) date, with a contract amount of \$15,000,000.  DEN is an economic engine for Colorado, generating \$36 billion a year for the region, and employing more than 40,000 employees. Peña Boulevard provides the primary roadway access to DEN while also offering connectivity to numerous off-airport developments and communities. To manage growth, maintain the reliability of the supply-chain, and continue to boost the local and regional economy, DEN must reconstruct Peña Boulevard pavement and address infrastructure deficiencies.
