A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a cash transfer from the General Government Private Grants Fund to the Climate Office Donations Fund.

WHEREAS, the Recycling Partnership Grant supported testing different recycling messages in different neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, this grant expired in February of 2020 with a cash balance of \$28,992.64; and

WHEREAS, the Recycling Partnership has authorized the City to use the unspent grant dollars to develop additional recycling outreach messaging; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Climate Action, Sustainability and Resiliency has determined that these dollars can be used in the Climate Office Donations Fund to support the City’s environmental and sustainability initiatives around recycling outreach;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. There is hereby authorized the transfer of cash from the General Government Private Grants Fund to the Climate Office Donations Fund in the amounts indicated in the following tabulation:
