For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Intergovernmental Agreement by and among the City and County of Denver and the City of Lakewood and the Denver Urban Renewal Authority concerning the Colfax Mainstreet Coalition IGA (the Coalition) and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver, City of Lakewood and the Denver Urban Renewal Authority operating as the Colfax Mainstreet Coalition IGA (the Coalition) was awarded an EPA Brownfields Assessment Grant in 2012 to conduct environmental assessments on behalf of developers seeking to redevelop properties along the Colfax Corridor that are or may become contaminated due to prior land uses, e.g. historical gas stations and drycleaners, which has prevented the property from being redeveloped;

**WHEREAS**, said Coalition has agreed to increase Denver's potential share amount from \$499,000 to \$850,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Intergovernmental Agreement;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

**Section 1.** The proposed Intergovernmental Agreement by and among the City and County of Denver, the City of Lakewood and the Denver Urban Renewal Authority concerning the Colfax Mainstreet Coalition IGA, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 2012-0526-A, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

**Section 2.** The payments made by the US Environmental Protection Agency via the Denver Urban Renewal Authority to the City and County of Denver pursuant to and under the Intergovernmental Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 14000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.
