DHHA is a sub-award recipient to FEMA Covid-19 Public Assistance grant funding. The city and DHHA combined their claims in 2020 such that the cumulative amounts would be larger. City and County of Denver is amending the current DHHA contract to extend the contract end date from December 31, 2024 to December 31, 2025, and increase the contract amount of \$24,480,730.93 by \$6,496,442.74 for a new contract total of \$30,977,173.67 to reflect approved obligation total by FEMA.

This amendment also serves to include management costs to the allowable activities in the scope of work. These costs relate to the administration of the FEMA Public Assistance award and are eligible for reimbursement under the City's award from FEMA.
