Section 2. That the Council finds and determines that property interests in these properties
are needed and required for the following public uses and public purposes: for the construction of
"HAWK".

28 **Section 3.** That Council authorizes the Mayor, including his duly authorized representatives, 29 in accordance with applicable federal, state, and City laws and rules and regulations adopted 30 pursuant thereto, to acquire the needed property interests, including, but not limited to, fee title, 31 permanent easements, temporary easements, fixtures, licenses, permits, improvements (including 32 without limitation, general outdoor advertising devices, buildings, and access points) and any other 33 rights, interests, and appurtenances thereto. Such authority includes the taking of all actions 34 necessary to do so without further action by City Council, including but not limited to: conducting 35 negotiations, executing all related agreements, making all necessary payments, taking any and all 36 actions required by law before instituting condemnation proceedings, allowing the temporary use of 37 City-owned land and conveying all or a portion of any City-owned land, including remnants, by 38 quitclaim deed, permanent or temporary easements, leases, licenses and permits.

39 **Section 4.** That if the interested parties do not agree upon the compensation to be paid for 40 the needed property interests, the owner or owners of the property are incapable of consenting, the 41 name or residence of any owner is unknown, or any of the owners are non-residents of the State, then the City Attorney of the City and County of Denver, upon the Mayor's direction, is authorized and empowered to exercise the City and County of Denver's eminent domain powers by instituting and, as necessary, prosecuting to conclusion proceedings under Article 1, Title 38, Colorado Revised Statutes, to acquire needed property interests upon, through, over, under and along the above-described property as necessary for the purposes set forth in Section 2 above.

6 Section 5. That the Council finds and determines that the Denver Department of 7 Transportation and Infrastructure and federal and state agencies may find the need to alter the 8 nature of the property interests or the legal descriptions of the properties referred to in this Ordinance 9 and may continue to do so in order to meet the needs of the Project. Council authorizes the Mayor. 10 including his duly authorized representatives, in accordance with applicable federal, state, and City 11 laws and rules and regulations adopted pursuant thereto, to acquire the property as the property 12 interests and legal descriptions are altered in accordance with the means authorized in this 13 Ordinance.

14 **Section 6.** That the Council hereby finds and determines that to improve the safety and 15 operation of pedestrians, bicycles and vehicles in the vicinity of the Project, it may be necessary to 16 rebuild, modify, remove, and relocate existing access points to streets located in the vicinity of the 17 Project.

Section 7. That the Council authorizes the City to acquire through negotiated purchase or
 condemnation all or any portion of any property interest as needed for the construction of "HAWK".

20 **Section 8.** That the City Council hereby finds and determines that the Project is necessary 21 for the health, safety, and welfare of the public.
