7 **Amending the Denver City Council Rules of Procedure concerning a deadline for**  
8 **referral of ballot measures by City Council.**

10 WHEREAS, § 3.3.5 of the Charter authorizes the City Council to make rules governing  
11 its procedures; and

12 WHEREAS, Sec. 13-6(a)(2), D.R.M.C. provides that the Council may adopt or amend  
13 its rules of procedure by resolution.

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**  
16 **DENVER:**

18 **Section 1.** That Rule 5 of the Denver City Council Rules of Procedure shall be amended by  
19 creating a new section, to read as follows:

20 5.14 Referral of Ordinance to Vote of the People. Final passage of any bill submitted to a  
21 vote of the people in a November coordinated election, pursuant to Denver Charter §3.3.6, must  
22 occur ninety (90) days prior to the coordinated election, except upon approval of the President.
