

# PROCLAMATION

**Proclamation CP11-0542**

**Declaring July 29, 2011 North High School Day  
in recognition of its complete renovation and refurbishing of  
the historic 1911 Building**

**WHEREAS**, the renovation of North High School - one of the oldest high schools in Colorado and the first in Denver - has been a two year effort, funded by the 2008 Denver Public Schools (DPS) Bond Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the major renovation includes a new library being named after the Ginn Family in honor of their long standing dedication to Denver Public Schools, North High School, and its students: Mr. Wally Ginn currently continues the tradition as head of the school alumni committee; and

**WHEREAS**, the new lecture hall is being named in honor of Paul Sandoval - the Paul Sandoval Lecture Hall - in honor of his contributions as a past Board Member, State Senator representing northwest Denver; small business owner, longtime donor to scholarships for DPS high school students, and advocate who always speaks to the heart; and

**WHEREAS**, members of the public are invited to join Mayor Michael B. Hancock, Councilwoman Judy H. Montero, North High School Alumni, other elected officials and supporters for the grand re-opening and dedication on Friday, July 29, 2011 DPS, from 10:00 am to 11:30 am.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** The Council declares Friday, July 29, 2011, as North High School Day in the City and County of Denver.

**Section 2.** That the Clerk of the City and County of Denver shall attest and affix the seal of the City and County of Denver to this proclamation.
