BR12- Approves a \$759,081 purchase order with EMC (EAPPS000002352) for 0354 an enterprise city-wide storage system upgrade and replacement.

RR12- Dedicates a parcel of land as public right-of-way in an alley as part of 0355 the site development for Advance Auto Parts on the northeast corner of W. Colfax and Vrain in Council District 1.

RR12- Dedicates three tracts as public right-of-way of Colfax between Zenobia 0356 and Yates and as alley between Colfax and 14th Ave. as part of site development for Renaissance West End Flats in Council District 1.

RR12- Dedicates a parcel of land as public right-of-way as Quentin St. at its 0357 intersection with 44th Ave in Council District 11.

RR12- Dedicates a parcel of land as public right-of-way as Peoria St. at its 0358 intersection with 45th Ave. as part of site development for La Quinta Inn & Suites DIA West in Council District 11.

RR12- Dedicates a parcel of land as public right-of-way as Larimer St. between 0359 Park Ave. and 24th St. as part of site development for 2300 Walnut/Arapahoe Square in Council District 9.

RR12- Grants a revocable permit to Clifford Beem to encroach into the public 0360 right-of-way with stairs, landing and railing in the alley behind 661 Williams St. in Council District 10.

RR12- Grants a revocable permit to 6th & Logan Associates to encroach into the public right-of-way with a portion of the shoring at 619 Logan St. in Council District 10.

RR12- Grants a revocable permit to the University of Colorado Denver to

0362 encroach into the public right-of-way with new conduit along Lawrence St. and utilization of existing conduit at Lawrence and 14th St. in Council District 8.
