1 BY AUTHORITY ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_ 2 COUNCIL BILL NO. 15-0023 3 SERIES OF COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE: 4 Finance 5 6 and Services 7 A BILL 8 For an ordinance amending Section 18-81, D.R.M.C. setting the salaries of elected 9 officers for terms beginning July 20, 2015 10 11 12 WHEREAS, the Colorado Constitution and Charter of the City and County of Denver 13 prohibit the salaries of elected officials from being increased or decreased during a term of 14 office; and 15 16 WHEREAS, section 9.2.2 of the charter requires the City Council to establish the 17 salaries for the ensuing term of elected Charter officers after January 1 of each year in 18 which a general city election will be held, but before the general election; and 19 20 WHEREAS, any increase in the salaries of elected officials is limited to the 21 cumulative increase in the Denver-Boulder-Greeley CPI or the cumulative increase in the 22 mean salary of employees in the Career Service, whichever is less; and 23 WHEREAS, the cumulative increase in the Denver-Boulder-Greeley CPI during the 24 25 period 2011 through 2014, inclusive, was 11.3%; and 26 27 WHEREAS, as reported by the Office of Human Resources, the cumulative increase in the mean salary of employees in the Career Service for the period 2011 through 2014, 28 29 inclusive, was 10.3%, meaning that the annual salaries of Denver elected officials cannot 30 increase in excess of 10.3% during the next four year term of the elected officials 31 commencing July 20, 2015. 32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF 33
