A BILL

For an Ordinance approving an Agreement for Grant of Easement with The George W. Clayton Trust, by its Trustee Clayton Early Learning, and Public Service Company for an easement located on the northerly edge of Park Hill Golf Course for relocation of electric transmission lines in furtherance of the construction of East Corridor FasTracks Project.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The Agreement for Grant of Easement with The George W. Clayton Trust, by its Trustee Clayton Early Learning, and Public Service Company, in the words and figures contained and set forth in that form of Agreement for Grant of Easement available in the office and on the web page of City Council, and to be filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk's Filing No. 13-0974, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That the Mayor and other proper officials of the City and County of Denver be and hereby are authorized, empowered and directed in the name and behalf of the City and County of Denver to execute the Agreement for Grant of Easement referenced above along with the Electric Transmission Line Easement attached to and incorporated into the Agreement for Grant of Easement, and to perform all acts as specified in the Agreement for Grant of Easement.
