Infrastructure & Culture

- BR15- Approves the connection of property outside the city at 3711 South 0036 Dahlia Street to City wastewater facilities.
- BR15- Vacates right-of-way adjacent to the property on the east side of 32 0037 Polo Club Circle in Council District 6.
- BR15- Relinquishes one 10-foot sanitary sewer easement at 3999 Colorado 0038 Boulevard in Council District 8.
- BR15- Adds \$40,000 to the intergovernmental agreement with the Town of 0039 Morrison and extends the term through 10-31-15 for wastewater treatment services at Red Rocks Amphitheater (CE45001(2)).
- BR15- Approves a \$945,575.70 contract with T. Lowell Construction, Inc. for a 0041 new storm sewer in Asbury Avenue, tying into the existing storm sewer at South Logan Street, upstream to South Clarkson Street in Council District 7 (201419282).
- BR15- Relinquishes an easement along Lots 1 - 6 of Block 1, Boulevard One 0044 Filing No. 1 in Council District 5.
- BR15- Relinquishes the hard surface easement created by the conditions of the 0045 vacation #2013-0585-01 3124 at West 20th Avenue in Council District 1.
- BR15- Relinquishes an easement on all of Tract H and a part of Lots 1 and 2 of 0046 Block 6 in Boulevard One Filing No. 1 in Council District 5.
- RR15- Approves the subdivision plat for Commons Subdivision Filing No. 10, 0052 bounded by 17th Street, 18th Street, Wewatta Street and Chestnut Place, in Council District 9.

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion.
