The contract funds the subsidized housing portion of the Warren Village First Step program which provides intensive case management services to women and single parent families who are homeless. The program funds 32 residences over the course of the year as well as services for the women/families, with the goal that 70% of clients will move to permanent housing after one year in this program.
