5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved

a. Scope of Work

This amendment is being requested to allow the contractor to provide full time employees working under this contract with Regional Transportation District (RTD) bus passes. The city will reimburse the contractor for 75% of the cost of these RTD passes. This bus pass amendment is the first step of a larger green initiative that will include bus passes in future Denver International Airport contracts. The intent of this green initiative is to encourage the use of RTD by contractor employees at DIA. We are also requesting a change to the language to allow the contractor to provide additional services for our parking patrons. These services include windshield repair or replacement, and dry cleaning pick up and drop off in addition to other services that may be offered in the future. These additional services will provide non airline revenue and provide services similar to those being offered by our off site partners.
