This clinic provides support for integrated health staffing, mental health, primary care health, substance abuse and case management providers. It provides onsite healthcare in a congregate setting, with the goal to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 among sheltered persons experiencing homelessness. The program currently supports an average of 10-15 patients per day.
