A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Funding Agreement between the City and County of Denver and State of Colorado, acting by and through the Department of Natural Resources, to restore wetlands, riparian areas, native uplands and to improve water quality relating to Westerly Creek from East 13th to East 11th Avenue and the funding therefor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Funding Agreement between the City and County of Denver and State of Colorado, acting by and through the Department of Natural Resources, in the words and figures contained and set forth in that form of Funding Agreement available in the office and on the web page of City Council, and filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk's Filing No. 2017-0013, is hereby approved.

Section 2. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the Grant Projects Fund, Accounting No. 38000, the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
