5. General description or background of proposed request. Attach executive summary if more space needed: Pursuant to the DDA Act (C.R.S. §§ 31-25-801, et seq.), City Council adopted Ordinance No. 400, Series of 2008, as subsequently amended by Ordinance No. 1659, Series of 2024 (Creation Ordinance), creating the Denver Downtown Development Authority (DDDA) and establishing a five-member Board; whereby, four members shall be qualified electors appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by City Council and the fifth member being the current City Council President. Members serve four-year terms, then are subject to reappointment. The Amended and Restated Plan of Development (Plan of Development), adopted by City Council in December 2024, contemplated expansion of the DDDA Board to better represent the diversity of electors within an expanded DDDA boundary, as well as subject matter expertise. The DDDA boundary has since marginally expanded; therefore, it is recommended to expand the DDDA Board from five to seven members, as contemplated in the Plan of Development. In addition, it is recommended to amend the Creation Ordinance to allow for either the current City Council President or a member of City Council appointed by the City Council President to serve on the DDDA Board, to allow for flexibility as the time commitment to carry out the purpose of the DDDA has substantially increased since the creation of the DDDA.
