For an ordinance establishing a "Denver Education Compact" fund in the General Government Special Revenue Fund and the means for authorizing expenditures from such fund.

WHEREAS, the Denver Education Compact (DEC) was established in 2011 as a collective impact effort to bring together the City and County of Denver, Denver Public Schools, higher education, and philanthropic, business and community stakeholders to focus efforts and resources on improving key educational outcomes; and

WHEREAS, the financial transactions of the DEC have been housed in the Mayor's Office Donations and Bequest Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Children's Affairs will now oversee the DEC program to ensure transparency and oversight of the financial reporting of the program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. There is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11000, a "Denver Education Compact" fund, Accounting No. 11861, for the purpose of handling financial transactions related to the Denver Education Compact program.

Section 2. Monies received into the Denver Education Compact fund, including donations, contributions, private grants, private partnerships, or other sources of private receipts, shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3 Expenditures are hereby authorized from the "Denver Education Compact" fund, Accounting No. 11861, in an amount not to exceed the total of deposits described in Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the Director of the Office of Children Affairs. Authorized expenditures will include but shall not be limited to personnel costs, programs, training, supplies and materials, and services related to the goals of the DEC.
