A BILL

For an ordinance concerning ballot designations of referred measures, initiatives, and referenda.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Section 15-9 (d) (6), D.R.M.C. is amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined to read as follows:

Sec. 15-9. Form of ballot questions.

(d) At any election at which an initiative, referendum, or referred ordinance is submitted to a vote of the qualified electors, the clerk and recorder must order and number the municipal ballot measures as follows:

- (1) Referred ordinances must be designated by a number and letter;
- (2) Initiatives and referenda must be designated by a number;
- (3) All referred ordinances must precede all initiatives and referenda;
- (4) Municipal ballot measures must be ordered as follows:
 - a. Referred ordinances to increase taxes;
 - b. Referred ordinances to retain excess revenues;
 - c. Referred ordinances to increase debt;
 - d. Other referred ordinances;
 - e. Referenda;
 - f. Initiatives to increase taxes;
 - g. Initiatives to retain excess revenues;
 - h. Initiatives to increase debt; and
 - i. Other initiatives.
- (5) Municipal ballot measures must be numbered as follows:
 - a. Referred ordinances must be numbered in the following series: 2A – 2Z.
 - b. Initiatives and referenda must be numbered in the following series: 300 – 399.

- 1 (6) The clerk and recorder shall number municipal ballot measures consecutively
2 starting from the last numeral and letter, or numeral, used in any previous
3 election until 2Z or 399 is used. ~~Only~~Except as stated in subsection (7) of this
4 section, only after a referred ordinance is numbered 2Z, or an initiative or
5 referendum is numbered 399, may the clerk and recorder reuse numbers or
6 letters.
- 7 (7) Notwithstanding the language of subsection (6) of this section:
- 8 a. If the total number of referred measures certified for the ballot in an election
9 is greater than the remaining letters in the series, the clerk and recorder shall
10 restart the series by designating the first referred measure for that election
11 as 2A.
- 12 b. If the total number of initiatives or referenda certified for the ballot in an
13 election is greater than the remaining numerals in the series, the clerk and
14 recorder shall restart the series by designating the first initiative or
15 referendum for that election as 300.
