Executive Summary

This contract engages Denver Public Schools (DPS) as the City's youth provider of the Denver Youth Employment Program (DYEP), replacing the former Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP) for the 2024 calendar year. In building off the SYEP, the DYEP has the capacity to provide year-round services in addition to the traditional paid summer internship.

The program will serve 750 eligible Denver youth with the following outputs/outcomes:

Total served - 750

Placement in paid summer internships – 550
Successful completion of summer internships – 466
Placement in year-round programming – 200
Successful completion of year-round program – 167

Additional outcomes to be tracked:
Participants retaining employment
Participants entering or returning to education
Demographic information
Income barrier information
Participants opening a non-custodial checking account
Participants opening a new savings account

DPS will provide recruitment, assessment, program enrollment, job development, placement, job coaching, financial literacy, career exploration and other customized workforce development services for eligible Denver youth. 550 of the 750 eligible youth will be placed in a summer youth experience, offering 120 hours of paid work experience at the current City minimum wage (\$2,194.80 in wages). Eligible youth include Denver residents who are: eligible to work in the United States between the ages of 14-21, attending secondary or post-secondary education, and who meets one of the following: family income standards, public assistance, free/reduced lunch, enrollment in title I school, residing in DEDO Neighborhood Equity and Stabilization (NEST) priority neighborhood, impacted disproportionately by the pandemic, or reside in high poverty area as defined by DOLA.

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
