Government & Finance

- BR13- Allows Sprint to install an amplifier to enable Sprint cellular phones to 0005 work inside the Denver Police Department Crime Lab facility (XC96016-01).

Health, Safety, Education & Services

- RR13- Appoints Chajito (Chy) Montoya and re-appoints Lori Grohskopf to the 0008 Human Services Citizen Review Panel for terms ending January 23, 2015.

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

- RR13- Grants a revocable permit to Denver Art Museum to encroach into the 0003 public alley right-of-way with an underground communication conduit bank and secondary electrical service to tie the new administration building to the Hamilton Building and related landscaping adjustments at 1226 N. Bannock St. in Council District 10.

- BR13- Approves Quit Claim of temporary easement rights acquired from Madre 0004 Investment Co. in 2006 for right-of-way for a temporary cul-de-sac on Quebec at Bellevue now to be platted as part of Bellevue Station Filing No. 3 in Council District 4.

Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion.
