SUMMARY: The purpose of this resolution is to dedicate 2 Tracts conveyed to The City and County of Denver. Said Tracts were created by the subdivisions: Stapleton Filing No. 5 and Stapleton Filing No. 9

It is requested that the above subject item be placed on the Mayor-Council Agenda for the next available date.

Each of these parcels of land were deeded to the City and County of Denver by a Special Warranty Deed recorded in the Office of the City and County of Denver, Clerk and Recorder: Tract A of Stapleton Filing No. 5 on January 16, 2007, under Reception Number 2007006463 and Tract J of Stapleton Filing No. 9 on July 22, 2015 under Reception Number 2015101444, Both to facilitate the Stapleton Filing No. 5 and 9 developments, which are located between 29th Ave. and Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. and between Quebec St. and Beeler St.

- (1) Uinta St., from 29th Ave. north to Uinta St. of Stapleton Filing No. 9, the land in the following described area:

Tract A, Stapleton Filing No. 5, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

- (2) Uinta St., from Uinta St. of Stapleton Filing No. 5 north to Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd., the land in the following described area:

Tract J, Stapleton Filing No. 9, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado;

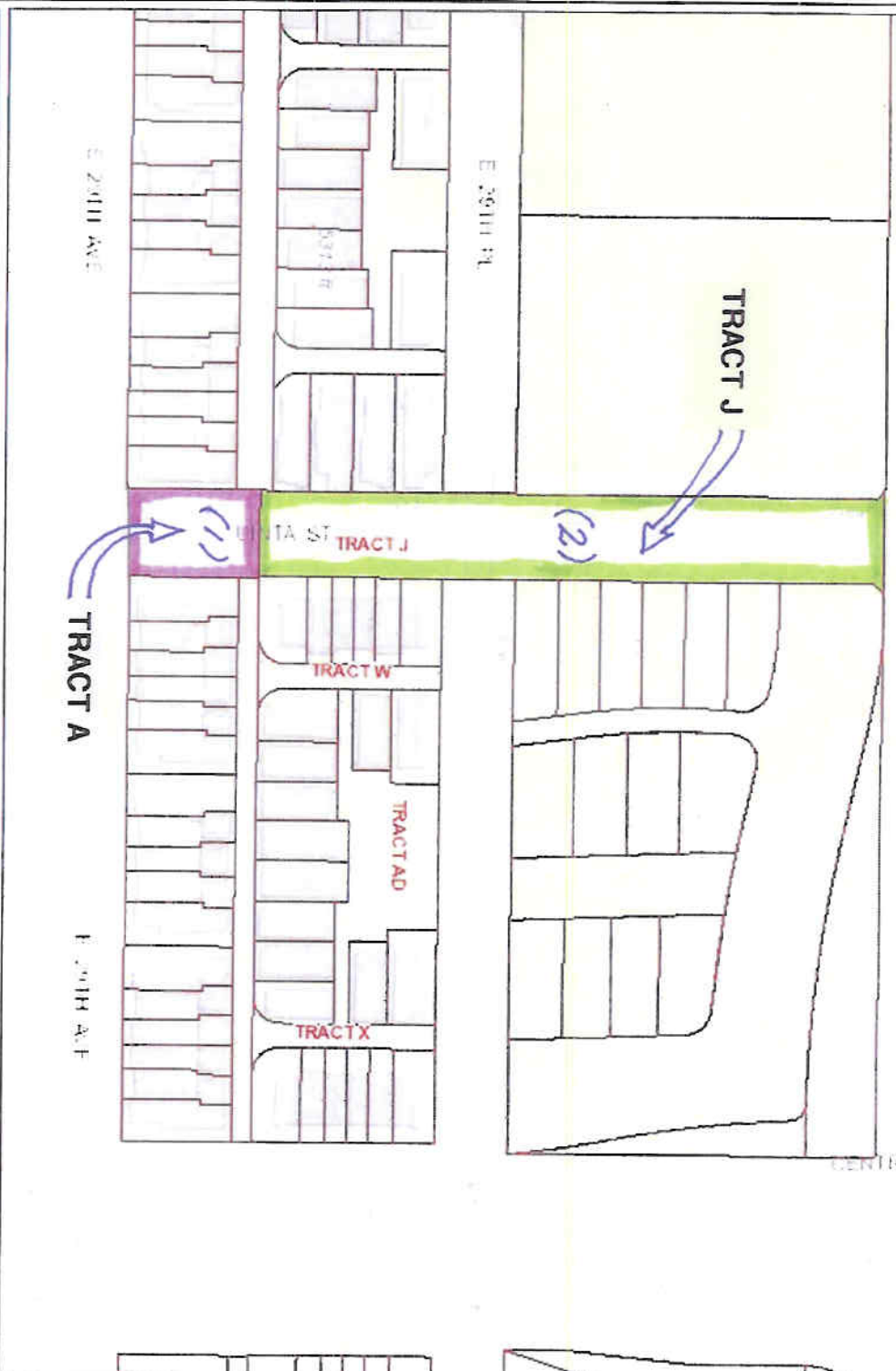
