Patrick Walton brings six years of operations experience spanning the corporate and nonprofit sectors to Mile High United Way as the Manager of the Office of the President and CEO.

In his current role, he serves as the central point of contact for the coordination of the CEO's activities, and works within the CEO's leadership team to manage a variety of strategic and operational initiatives.

Previously serving as Mile High United Way's Operations Manager, Patrick managed the organization's 63,000-square-foot building, the Mile High United Way Morgridge Center for Community Change. Located in the historic Curtis Park Neighborhood, the building includes the CoBank Leadership Center, a community conference space that has welcomed over 80,000 members of our community since its opening.

Prior to joining Mile High United Way, he managed the guest services team at the Oxford Hotel in Downtown Denver as the Front Office Manager. During his time at the Oxford Hotel, it was designated by Conde Nast Traveler as one of the top 50 luxury hotels in the United States.

Patrick's experience also includes working on several political campaigns, as well as project management for the Katalysis Network, a MicroFinance organization based in Central America.

He was a graduate of the Denver Metro Chamber Leadership Foundation's 2016 Impact Denver Class and is currently serving on Denver's Road to Work's Business Advisory Committee, which assists in the employment and support services for adults with barriers to employment. Patrick is also on the Board of The Blossom Project, a nonprofit which uses a collaborative model to inspire high school girls to create visionary change in their communities, country, and around the globe.
