A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase in the Clerk and Recorder's Elections Division General Fund budget.

WHEREAS, the Clerk and Recorder's Elections Division needs to replace their ballot mail sorter to meet statutory deadlines for ballot processing, counting and tabulation for the mid-term /gubernatorial general election; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1284, Series of 2021, the Annual Appropriation Ordinance, authorized the 2022 spending allocation in the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, due to projected savings within the Elections Division 2022 General Fund operating budget there are funds available to purchase the ballot mail sorter in 2022; and

WHEREAS, said ballot mail sorter is over the \$50,000 threshold for capital equipment items that require City Council approval, per the Denver Revised Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, this bill request authorizes the purchase of a ballot mail sorter;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the General Fund, Accounting No. 01010, the Clerk and Recorder, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:
