The Denver Police Department (DPD) has been awarded grant funding from the Colorado Department of Transportation for a three-year project, with funding evaluated and approved each year within the three-year period. This amendment and additional funds will continue to support DPD's initiative to further reduce the number of serious and fatal crashes related to impaired driving by increasing the number of impaired driving arrests. The funding is used specifically to pay for officer overtime to work saturated patrols focused on impaired driving.

Scope of work:

To combat the ongoing issue of impaired driving in the City, DPD will conduct 20 saturation patrols within Denver. By increasing contacts using tools such as saturation patrols, DPD's goal is to educate the public on the dangers of impaired driving and remove people participating in such behaviors from the roads. This funding is strictly for officer overtime, which includes events/holidays such as Fall Festivals, Halloween weekend, Thanksgiving weekend, Holiday parties in December, New Years weekend, Winter Blitz, Super Bowl weekend, St. Patrick's Day weekend, spring events, Memorial Day weekend, Summer Blitz, Fourth of July weekend, Sturgis Rally, and Labor Day weekend. The DUI team determines how many officers are needed for each event. Additionally, DPD partners with Mother's Against Drunk Drivers (MADD) annually to bring awareness to the community with this grant. Other awareness events have included the Denver Police Teen Academy, and Kart Racing for Heroes. Funding from this grants supports officer overtime to participate in these events.
