**A BILL**

**For an ordinance making a rescission, appropriation, and a cash transfer from Denver Human Services Special Revenue Fund to the Border Crisis Response Special Revenue Fund.**

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to reallocate funds from the Denver Human Services Special Revenue Fund to the Denver Human Services Border Crisis Response Special Revenue Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, said funds will support personnel and services and supplies costs related to support for asylum seekers coming into Denver from outside of the US border;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** From appropriations heretofore made from the Human Services Special Revenue Fund, listed or indicated in the following tabulation, there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded":
