A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase from the Risk Management Fund (SRF 11838) Fund for the Denver Fire Department.

WHEREAS, the Denver Fire Department (DFD) is seeking approval for a capital equipment purchase of a first responder vehicle to support with coverage all of Fire District 6 responses and help cover Fire Districts 2, 3, and 7 on big fire events; and

WHEREAS, said vehicle is a replacement of a City-owned vehicle that was in an auto accident and determined as totaled while in service; and

WHEREAS, said replacement vehicle purchase is authorized to be paid from out of the Department of Finance (DOF), Risk Management Special Revenue (11838); and

WHEREAS, because this is a capital equipment purchase above the fifty-thousand dollars threshold, DFD requires City Council authorization to purchase said vehicle;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Risk Management Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. (11838), the Chief Financial Officer, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:

Truck	1

The foregoing vehicle purchase is to support the operations of the DFD.

Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
