There will be no negative financial impact to the City from management of the Conveyance Inspections program; on the contrary, there will be a positive financial impact, since the projected revenue stream is significantly more than the cost of the one Career Service Authority position hired for this program and all associated equipment necessary for the program.

Other than the one position hired for this program, the program will be handled by Fire Prevention's current staff, which manages several other safety / revenue-generating programs. The actual inspections will continue to be contracted by the property owner, as they have been for many years, and will be conducted by certified elevator inspectors; in most cases, the same individuals who have been conducting the inspections all along. The property owner will experience little if any difference as a result of the program transfer, but we believe Denver's conveyances will be safer for citizens and first responders.
