A BILL

For an ordinance amending Article II of Chapter 6 to repeal the sunset date for entertainment districts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That section 6-23 of the Code shall be amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined, to read as follows:

Sec. 6-23. - ~~Sunset~~; Report to city council.

~~(a) — This article II shall be effectively repealed five (5) years after the effective date of the ordinance.~~

~~(b) —~~ The director shall report in writing to city council by April 15 of each year, ~~beginning in 2024~~, on the operation of the entertainment district and common consumption area licensing program.
