33	Fund shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Fund No. 34806, which is se				

forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

1	Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Climate Federal Capital Projects" Fund				
2	Accounting No. 34806, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Office of Climate Action				
3	Sustainability and Resiliency. Authorized expenditures for Accounting No. 34806 include capita				
4	improvements, such as sustainable transportation, building electrification, energy efficiency, solar
