

That portion of Lot 43 through 44, Block 9, Villa Park Subdivision, as recorded on May 4th, 1888; Book 5, Page 38, Section 5, Township 4 South, Range 68 West, 6th Principle Meridian, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 44 thence S00°10′33″W a distance of 50.00 ft to the southeast corner of Lot 43, thence N89°35′06″W a distance of 3.50 ft, thence N00°10′33″E a distance of 50.00, thence S89°35′06″E a distance of 3.50 ft to the point of beginning.
