6. **General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:**

Ordinance No. 705 (Series 2007) created the “Environmental Services Seed Capital Program” and “Environmental Services Seed Capital Fund” (fund number 78500). This ordinance seeks to amend that ordinance to rename the fund and program, and expand the fund’s purpose. This will give the Department of Environmental Health’s Environmental Quality division, which operates the fund, more flexibility with regards to how money in the fund can be spent. Specific changes requested are as follows:

- Change the fund and program name wherever they appear in the original ordinance from “Environmental Services Seed Capital Fund”/“Environmental Services Seed Capital Program” to “Environmental Capital Fund”/“Environmental Capital Program” (keep fund number the same).
- Expand the fund purpose by adding the bolded and underlined language to and deleting the stricken language from Section 1: “There is hereby established in the Environmental Services Enterprise Fund, Fund No. 7800, an “Environmental ~~Services Seed Capital~~” Program, Accounting No. 78500-6506103-EZ500 **for the purpose of providing funds for projects and programs that support environmental sustainability, minimize long-term environmental and financial liability for the City and County of Denver, and remediate environmental liabilities.** ~~The purpose of said Environmental Services Seed Capital program is to support the initial development of worthy environmentally sustainable projects or programs in the city of Denver.”~~
