A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing expenditures from the Dental Self-Insurance Fund.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver provides dental benefits to employees on a self-funded basis; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to reimburse providers on a claim by claim basis, and these payments are made from the Dental Self-Insurance Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Dental Self-Insurance Fund receives revenue from the City and employees through the payroll deduction process; and

WHEREAS, in 2020, the Office of Human Resources is requesting an appropriation in the Dental Self-Insurance Fund to cover civilian, sheriff, police, and fire employees and their dependents, as projected through Open Enrollment for 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Expenditures are hereby authorized in 2020 from the Dental Self-Insurance Fund, Accounting No. 59000, the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
