a. Scope of Work

Arts & Venues Denver, formerly Theatres & Arenas, has an existing bid/agreement with Aramark Facility Services (AFS) for housekeeping services at Red Rocks Amphitheatre, the Denver Coliseum, and Boettcher Concert Hall. The existing agreement was executed through a bid document with the Department of Purchasing. This Amendatory Agreement amends the "Payment" section to extend maximum payable amount from \$9,000,000.00 to \$12,000,000.00 to accommodate expenditures through the contract term which is October 31, 2012 and at which time we will be submitting a bid proposal for services.
