6 7 8	For an ordinance granting a certificate of designation to the Denver Zoological Foundation, Inc. to operate a waste to energy system at the Denver Zoo.			
9	WHEREAS, the City has authority pursuant to Article VII of Chapter 48, Denver Revised			
10	Municipal Code and pursuant to § 30-20-101 et seq., C.R.S. to issue certificates of designation for			
11	solid waste disposal facilities in the City and County of Denver; and			
12	WHEREAS, no solid wastes disposal facility may be operated in Denver without a certificate			
13	of designation issued by the City; and			
14	WHEREAS, the Denver Zoological Foundation, Inc. has submitted an application for a			
15	certificate of designation for solid wastes disposal facility, as required by law; and			
16	WHEREAS, the waste to energy system will be used to convert waste generated at the			
17	Denver Zoo and urban forest residue from Denver Parks into energy that will power the Denver			
18	Zoo; and			
19	WHEREAS, the waste to energy system will be located	d at the Denver Zoo in an area where		
20	no residential development exists or is allowed; and			
21	WHEREAS, because the waste to energy system will be	be located at the Denver Zoo it will be		
22	convenient and accessible to its primary user, the Denver Zoo	ological Foundation, Inc.; and		
23	WHEREAS, because the waste to energy system will	have no adverse effect on the use or		
24	value of property in the vicinity; and			
25	WHEREAS, the Denver Department of Environmental	Health has reviewed the application		
26	submitted by the Denver Zoological Foundation, Inc. and rec	commended approval with conditions;		
27	and			
28	WHEREAS, Colorado Department of Public Health	and Environment has reviewed the		
29	application submitted by the Denver Zoological Foundation,	nc. and recommended approval with		
30	conditions; and			
31	WHEREAS, City Council, has reviewed the recon	nmendations of the Department of		
32	Environmental Health and the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and has			
33	held a public hearing at a regular council meeting, as requ	ired by §48-102(c), Denver Revised		
34	Municipal Code; and			

WHEREAS, City Council has duly considered the factors set forth in §48-103, Denver Revised Municipal Code.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

- **Section 1**. A certificate of designation, in the form of this ordinance, is hereby issued to the Denver Zoological Foundation, Inc. for a solid wastes disposal facility. This certificate of designation may not be transferred, assigned or conveyed.
- **Section 2**. The responsible operator of this facility shall be the Denver Zoological Foundation, Inc. The operator shall be solely liable for operating the facility in accordance with the terms of this certificate of designation and all applicable laws.
- **Section 3**. The certificate of designation is issued for the operation of a waste to energy system to dispose of waste generated at the Denver Zoo and urban forest residue from Denver Parks and convert this waste into energy that will power the Denver Zoo.
- **Section 4**. The solid waste disposal site and facility is located in a building at the Denver Zoo at 2300 Steele Street, Denver Colorado 80205.
- **Section 5**. The waste to energy system shall operate in accordance with the terms and conditions of the design and operational plan in the Application for Certificate of Designation Solid Waste Incinerator Facility at the Denver Zoo dated October 10, 2014, in accordance with the conditions imposed in both the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment approval letter dated July 29, 2014 and the Denver Department of Environmental Health approval memorandum dated October 14, 2014, as the regulatory agencies may allow each of these documents to be amended from time to time. Copies of these documents are attached and incorporated in this certificate of designation.
- **Section 6**. This certificate of designation shall be filed with the City Clerk and shall be recorded in the real property records of the Clerk and Recorder of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk's Filing No. \_\_\_\_\_\_. Any amendments to the operating conditions shall be filed and recorded in the same manner as this certificate of designation.
- **Section 7**. This certificate of designation may be temporarily suspended or revoked for cause, after reasonable notice and public hearing.
