(2) RiNo will be granted access to the Event Site to provide all services related to the multi-day activities under this agreement, so long as such activities are compatible and appropriate as allowed for City-owned properties, and those activities provide recreational and social activities, events and programming for the enjoyment of the local community and general public. (3) RiNo will be responsible for the funding, design, construction, and daily operation of park, including maintenance. (4) The City will provide daily trash removal and administrative support as it relates to City services. (5) There will be no compensation to the City; nor does the City have any financial obligations.
