A BILL

For an ordinance amending the City Retail Sales Tax Article, Article II, Chapter 53 of the Revised Municipal Code to clarify the exemption for sales and deliver to purchasers residing or doing business outside of the city.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Subsection 26(9), Article II (City Sales Tax Article), Chapter 53 (also known and cited as Section 53-26(9)) of the Revised Municipal Code is amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined to read as follows:

(9) Sales of tangible personal property to a purchasers residing or doing business outside the city, where provided delivery thereof is made to ~~such purchaser at such~~ the purchaser's residence or business address ~~of the purchaser~~ outside the city by the vendor: on the vendor's vehicle; by common, contract, or commercial carrier that is hired by the vendor or by the conveyance of the seller, or by mail.
