2024 On-Call Construction Services - Bridge & Structural Project Delivery (SMALL)**

Fact Sheet

Purpose of Procurement

The City identified the need to establish a group of qualified On-Call General Contractors available to respond to bidding requests for the City’s construction work. This work includes construction work on bridges, culverts, and/or miscellaneous structures that facilitate vehicular and pedestrian traffic as well as electrical elements that facilitate lighting in these areas. At the time the need was identified, it was anticipated that 5-6 contracts would be awarded for three-year terms at \$15M each. DSBO’s review of the scope of work and associated tasks (outlined below) resulted in an MWBE goal of 12%.

Funding

Funding is not committed at this time. Authorization of work and commitment of funds are made via work order on an as-needed basis.

Procurement

The Selection Criteria for this procurement were reviewed by the Selection Committee and approved by DOTI Executive Management in December 2023. The criteria used to evaluate the submittals includes: Contractor Qualifications, Personnel Qualifications, Project Expertise, Project Approach, Technical Accuracy, Quality and Safety, Diversity and Inclusiveness, Bonding Capacity, and Contractors Prequalification.

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Advertisement of the Request for Qualifications began on September 13, 2023, and submittals were due October 18, 2020. Nine (9) firms responded to the Request for Qualifications; all submittals were reviewed and scored by the Selection Committee; six (6) firms were directly selected to contract with the City.
